His knowledge pertaining to these religions was extensive, deep and penetrating, and his perceptions sharp and brilliant. Convinced that the truth was one and so was true religion, Ibn Hazm was determined to see that unity is established as the ultimate criterion of religious diversity.

With his usual logical vigour, he first sought to demonstrate the Existence, Oneness, and Transcendence of God on the basis of reason, common sense perception, and intuition, with a view to establishing this fact as the first principle of all religions. He argues for the reality and necessity of revelation and the ability of the prophets to provide mankind with the knowledge, guidance, and principles of religio-moral laws in order for felicity in this world and the Hereafter to be achieved.

He is the first Muslim scholar who takes the Qur'anic charge of tahrif (distortion) against the followers of earlier revealed scriptures, especially, the Bible (both Hebrew and Christian), in its most extreme and literal sense.
