Ritual takes place over a period of six days in the 1960s when a clerical servant in Colombo decides to go to Point Pedro to visit his family. He attends to household chores, plays with his children, visits his neighbors, listen to gossip about the people around, gets increasingly frustrated when all his attempts to sleep with his wife fail, and finally

returns to Colombo to continue his humdrum life.
