Comparative political economy in Asia goes back a long time. For some time, it seemed that high-growth Southeast Asian economies could join the momentum of the Asian tigers, as in Mahathir's Look East policy and the World Bank's Miracle Eight, but these

expectations have since faded into the background. Arguments about differences between China and India have been ongoing for decades, in short, one state-led, efficient and authoritarian, the other democratic with an inefficient and reactive rather than proactive state. The rise of China (especially after China joined the WTO in 2001) has added further ramifications. The ongoing rise of Asia prompts questions: Which Asia? What about differences within Asia? Rise on what terms? How does Asia position itself in the world economy? With Japan's lead Asia could still, to a point, follow American directions, as in security policies and the Asian Development Bank, but with China as Asia's leading economy, this is no longer the case. In Asia capitalism has mostly figured as a category in the singular with variations in the margins: market economies with variations in degrees and styles of state guidance, in historical trajectories and institutional makeup, and in rent-seeking and crony capitalism. Counterpoints have been socialist economies (China, Vietnam, Laos, North Korea), and outliers have been economies steeped in military influence (Pakistan, Myanmar, Indonesia, Thailand). This is the backdrop to the emergence of the theme of capitalisms in Asia. This theme means that Asian discussions join a wider comparative political economy and analysis of comparative capitalisms and that analytics take on a more reflexive and critical character.

A young adult novel recounting the devastation of a victim of Japanese military sexual slavery

- The first young adult novel to paint a vivid and realistic depiction of the “comfort women”
- The story of the young girls whose bodies and souls were trampled in their blossoming youth as they were dragged from their hometowns across foreign lands from Inner Mongolia and Shanghai, China, to Leyte Island in the Philippines Many are

familiar with the history of the “comfort women,” the victims of Japanese military sexual slavery, but how much do they really know? Few fully understand exactly why and how the girls came to be “comfort women,” the scope of the assault they endured at the “comfort stations” set up throughout regions colonized by Japan including Korea, and how they lived out their lives after they returned Korea post-liberation. There are limits to how much of the truth can be exposed to children and teens due to the sensitive nature of the subject, which is why previously published children’s and young adult novels that have attempted to address this tragedy fell short of capturing the actual extent of the damage and suffering. Simply acknowledging the tragedy as a historical fact and fully portraying the depth of reality and pain of the victims are vastly different propositions, which makes the publication of *Trampled Blossoms*, an honest and vivid depiction of the victims’ accounts of sexual slavery under the Japanese military, all the more meaningful.

This book introduces the concept and research achievements of Asian Women s Studies and is designed as one of the [EGEP BOOK series]. The Ewha Global Empowerment Program (EGEP), a womens education program for Asian and African female activists, is a curriculum organized by Ewha Womans Universitys Center for Asian Womens Studies. The contents of the main lectures of Asian womens researchers were selected.

Despite the efforts of Asian female scholars, Asian womens studies are still understood as regional womens studies based on geographical and physical areas of Asia. In this book, Asian womens theology is based on the experience and life of Asian women, feminist theory newly constructed in the context of Asia, and a practical work that resists oppression against women and solidifies global change . The first part of the book, which is composed of 12 chapters in two parts, examines the development of Asian womens studies including the concept of Asian womens studies, and compares how womens studies have been institutionalized in Korea, China and Japan. Based on these considerations, we try to theorize about Asian feminist pedagogy. Part 2 discusses issues of womens movements in Asia such as Korea, Indonesia and India, focusing on topics such as sexuality, womens movement, and anti-violence movement, and explores the possibility of a transnational womens movement.

This is the first theoretical introduction to Asian womens studies in a systematic way. This book aims to widen the understanding of Asian womens studies and to establish an Asian feminist community through transnational womens solidarity.
