His fame as a painter has obscured his significance as a poet not so well know, there is the fact that he was one of the few poets of any stature in contemporary Sri Lanka. He has also proclaimed his precepts and practice as a painter in a few notable essays on the vision of the painter, and art in relation to the beholder and pervading reality.
